**BOOT CAMP '26**

The Texas Society of Plastic Surgeons is excited to offer **Boot Camp '26** at UT Health San Antonio Long School of Medicine in collaboration with the American Society of Plastic Surgeons (ASPS), with support from plastic surgery programs and faculty across the state.

Boot Camp was originally created by ASPS in 2018 to address evolving trends in graduate medical education. The **TSPS Boot Camp** program aims to aid the transition of Integrated and Independent residents into plastic surgery training by offering standardized exposure to crucial clinical content. The program is designed to ensure accountability in trainee education and to stay at the forefront of adult surgical education.

Returning after a highly successful 2025 debut, our second annual event will advance community and mentorship among emerging plastic surgeons, featuring distinguished academic leaders, including program directors and chairs.

**LOCATION**

**Boot Camp '26** will be held at UT Health San Antonio Long School of Medicine, offering a dynamic learning experience across multiple state-of-the-art facilities.

Participants will rotate between the Surgical Simulation Lab for hands-on procedural training, the Johnson Center for small group learning and mentorship, and the Academic, Learning, and Teaching Center (ALT-C building) for interactive lectures and workshops, providing the perfect environment to develop skills, connect with peers, and engage with leaders in plastic surgery.

### **OBJECTIVES**

**TSPS Boot Camp '26** aims to offer standardized and timely exposure to crucial clinical content in plastic surgery, ensuring accountability for the comprehensive education of our trainees and maintaining leadership in adult surgical education. Its primary objective is to facilitate the seamless transition of both Integrated and Independent residents into plastic surgery training.

### **PROGRAM DETAILS**

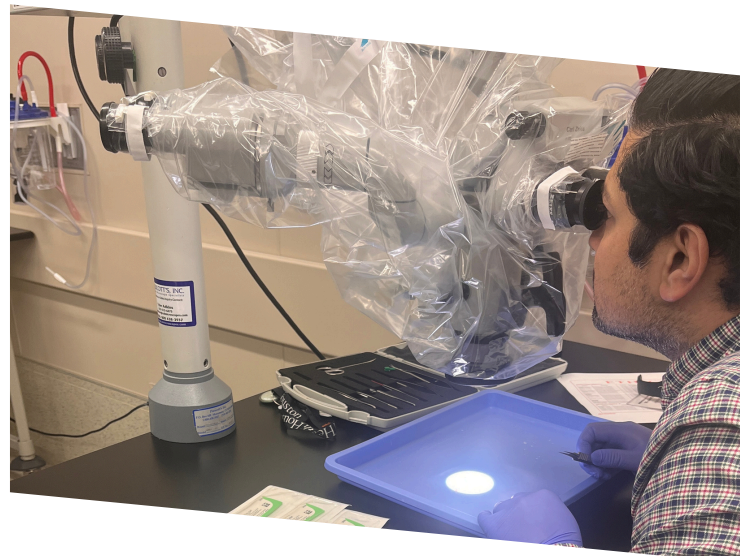
**TSPS Boot Camp '26** will host two days of learning and collaboration.

Friday will host a welcome reception and dinner. Saturday will be a full-day of education and an evening dinner off-site. Sunday will conclude after a half-day program.

**TSPS Boot Camp '26** offers breakout sessions in topics at the forefront of plastic surgery. Residents experience a wide variety of clinical areas including wound healing, burn management, cleft and craniofacial reconstruction, and microsurgery.

Additionally, residents are introduced to aesthetic procedures such as botulinum toxin injections, filler injections, and breast implant options.

Attendees acquire the foundational knowledge necessary to advance into more specialized areas of plastic surgery. Through enhanced resident training, **Boot Camp '26** contributes to the delivery of high-quality patient care.



**FACULTY**

Prominent academic faculty from across Texas are invited to lead **TSPS Boot Camp '26**. These distinguished faculty surgeons are comprised of Residency Program Directors, as well as Department Chairs and Division Chiefs - each genuinely engaged in providing the best possible training for the next generation of plastic and reconstructive surgeons.
