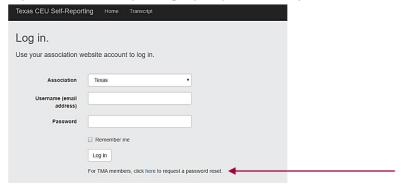


How to Self-report CME - Screenshots

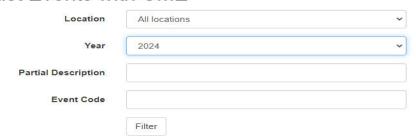

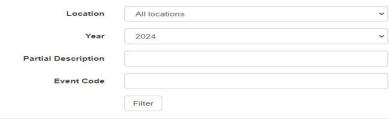
- Step 1: For **Location**, choose the city/town where the event was held (or "On-Line)
- Step 2: For Year, choose the correct year for the event
- Step 3: Select Filter
